Welcome back! We hope you had a lovely summer.

Learning Challenge

Our Learning Challenge this half term will be 'Knowleswood Detectives'. We will be investigating our new classroom and each of the different areas of provision. We will begin making friends with the new children in our class and will get to know the new teachers.

In English we will look at the books 'Macavity', 'Burglar Bill' and '006 and a bit.' We will think about the different characters in the stories and will explore the themes of problem solving.

We will also be starting our daily phonic lessons where children will learn a specific letter sound each day. Lots of opportunities to learn the daily sound will be placed in the provision in the classroom for the children access independently.

In Maths we will be focusing on understanding numbers. The children will be given lots of opportunities to explore numbers and counting, along with number recognition from 0-10.



Reading Books

Your child will be receiving a reading book this term. Your child will learn to read the book at school with one of the Reception team. Once your child is confident at reading the book we will then allow them to take the book home for them to share and discuss with you. Along with your child's book there will be a reading log book where you can record when you have listened to them read and add any comments that you feel are important.


