- We will continue to work on our number skills.

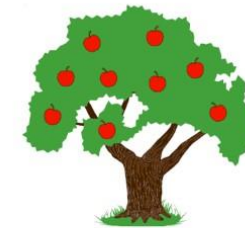
PE
