

MATHS



This term in Maths we will be looking at:

Fractions - Children will be learning how to make a whole, working with tenths and finding fractions of amount and of objects. Once they have a solid understanding of fractions, they will order, compare and find equivalent fractions

Measurement and time - Children will be learning how to tell the time using both digital and analogue clocks. They will be able to estimate and read time with increasing accuracy to the nearest minute. Children will begin to compare durations of time.

Geometry (properties of shape) - Children will begin to recognise angles. Identifying a right angle and angles that are more or less than one. They will identify horizontal, vertical and pairs of perpendicular lines. Children will recognise and describe 3d shapes.

Measurement and mass and capacity - We will compare, add and subtract mass and capacity, solving problems.

Children will continue to learn their times tables in school.
