We would like to let you know about some upcoming work that will be taking place on our school site.

You may know that for over two years now we have not been able to play or take part in any activities on our field / grassed areas because the land is too dangerous for us. The site used to be for landfill and the materials from that are now coming out at the surface. We have gardens, a pond, play areas and an outdoor classroom that we have not been able to use at all.

It has been difficult to enjoy playtimes and sport sessions in the way that we should and even our sports days have had to take place on the concrete playground.



That is why we are excited to let you know that Braford Council have now agreed to fix it for us! We are going to have a large grassed area, a MUGA (multi use games area), a garden and some quiet spaces for us to enjoy.

Lots of work is needed in order to sort out our field and there will be lots of lorries and heavy machinery required. The main work will happen in January and should last for around 2 weeks. The work force will be accessing the site through the back drive, on Haslemere Close. We know that this will cause some disruption and we are really happy that we have such great neighbours who we know will support us with this project!



When the lorries are moving up and down the drive there will be a Banksman (to supervise and keep pedestrians safe) there at all times and a road sweeper is also going to be on site to make sure mud on the roads is kept to a minimum.
