

In English we will be learning:-

To write extended pieces of writing using conjunctions, expanded noun phrases and a range of sentence types.

Our stories this term are 'Handa's Surprise', 'Katie Morag' and 'The lighthouse Keeper's Lunch'.

How can you help your child?

Listen to your child read at home at least 3 times a week and record this in their diary.

Help your child with any homework sent home.

Give opportunities for your child to practice writing their year 1 and year 2 common exception words.
