

Maths



In Maths we will be learning about:

- Adding and subtracting two-digit numbers.
- Money – Adding, subtracting and finding change.
- Multiplication and Division – Understanding how to count in 2s, 5s and 10s. Learning our 2,5 and 10 times tables and understanding that division is the opposite of multiplication.

English



We will begin the half term by learning how to read and write instructions. We will then write our own scary, spooky recipes linked to our story 'Bone Soup'. We will also learn how to write poetry about fireworks. We will read a text called 'The Conqueror' and take on the roles of the different characters. We will learn about how authors use interesting language and the impact this has on the reader.

Linked to our history topic, we will learn how to write an information book about the Queen.

We will finish the term by reading, telling, innovating and writing festive stories.

History – The Great Fire of London

In History this half term we will be focusing on two historical events. First, we will investigate the events of the Gunpowder Plot that led to Bonfire Night. Then, we will study the Great Fire of London and decide whether or not it improved London for those living there. We will learn how to interpret evidence from the time and afterwards, examining whether the sources are reliable.

Our big finish will involve creating a model of the great fire of London, exploring mechanisms and how we could make the 'fire' move over London.
