



The Power of Discussion

Here are some useful tips and questions to ask whilst reading a book with your child:

- ★ What has happened in the book so far? Can you summarise the plot/text in ten words?
- ★ What do you think might happen next? What are the clues that make you think this?
- ★ Where is the story set? (For example: a forest, the seaside, a castle etc.)
- ★ Who are the characters in the story? Who do you like/dislike and why?
- ★ Pick out three of your favourite words or phrases from this section of the book. Can you explain why you chose them?

Your child's class teacher has assigned the relevant book band level to your child and this is updated on a regular basis.

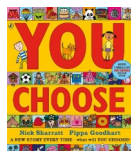
