## Learning

Our topic this half term will be 'Nice to meet you'. We will be focusing our activities each week around different books relating to starting Nursery, making friends and finding out more about ourselves. The Learning focus on what we do at Nursery and following the classroom rules and routines. Some of the books we are focusing on are:

- Nursery rhymes
- The Colour Monster
- Owl babies

The children will also be given lots of opportunities to explore numbers, considering counting in sequence and touch counting accurately. They will also be encouraged to draw and make marks and give meaning to the marks they make.

## Reading

In our classroom the children have a wide variety of books for them to explore and read. We encourage parents to read with their children at home to extend their vocabulary and listening skills. We will be reading a range of books that fit with our topic this half term.
