#### Homework tasks and fun activities

A homework grid will be sent home for you and your children to complete throughout the Summer term. These activities link to the learning we will be doing in Year 1. Please share any pictures of work completed with your child's teacher.

NumBots – Your child will be receiving a NumBots log in. Numbots is an excellent way for young children to improve their number recognition and fluency. Please encourage your child to play for 5 – 10 minutes a day. Reading – As stated above, it is important for Year 1 children to be reading as regularly as possible. This can include you reading books with them at bedtime, listening to audio stories or sharing a story together at the weekend. Year 1 children should have also received a log in for Bug Club. Children have been assigned a book on Bug Club according to their ability levels. Please ensure you are accessing Bug Club and reading one book a week with your child.
