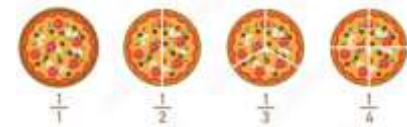

Practise telling the time! Write a diary about a day in your life, including all of the times you usually do your favourite things. See if you can tell the time every time you look at the clock!

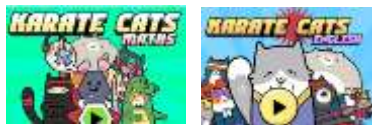
